TO 1.10**MODEL: **BKM-15R**

DESCRIPTION

BKM-15R software cannot be upgraded from V1.01 to V1.10 using the memory stick. Operation is normal after the upgrade; however, the software version displayed on the STATUS (2/2) menu is still "1.01.00."

This occurs because the file attribute of controller software "BKM15Rbl3" is set to Writing Unavailable. As a result, no new version files can be written. Reset the file attribute as described in the following procedure.

RESET PROCEDURE

1. Connect a straight-type Ethernet cable between BKM-15R and the PC.
2. Set the NETWORK switch on the rear of BKM-15R to PEER TO PEER.
3. Connect the PC and BKM-15R with terminal software, such as HyperTerminal.

Host Address: **192.168.0.100**Port Number: **23**Connecting method: **TCP/IP**

NOTE: Set the IP address of your PC to 192.168.0.xxx in advance. (xxx cannot be 100.)

4. Enter the following user name and password:

User name: **super**Password: **user**

5. When the Super prompt is displayed, enter the following attribute command:

attr /flb0/usercmd/BKM15Rbl3 -w

NOTE: Check that the following appears on the next line after entering the command:

----e-r-e-r-ewr /flb0/usercmd/BKM15Rbl3

6. Reset the connection of the BKM-15R LAN terminals and the NETWORK switch.
7. Upgrade BKM-15R.

CONFIRMATION

Confirm that software is V1.10.00 from STATUS (2/2) > CONTROLLER STATUS.

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
