### INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Install the new software as follows:
  - a. Insert the SRAM card in the control panel.
  - b. Turn the power switch (in rear) off and on.
  - **NOTE:** If the rear power switch is inaccessible, restart by selecting SETUP/EXTEND MENU/ RESTART MONITOR. (The Extend menu is only available on units with V1.20 or higher; the factory password is 1111.)
  - c. Confirm that the monitor STANDBY LED is blinking slowly (on: 1.5 seconds, off: 0.5 seconds).
  - d. Turn the power on from the control panel to begin the version upgrade.

*NOTE:* The STANDBY LED blinks rapidly (on: 0.5 seconds, off: 0.5 seconds) during the upgrade, which takes approximately 5 minutes to complete.

- 2. Confirm the software version as follows:
  - a. Select STATUS (2/3) menu.
  - b. Verify that the software version is 1.40.
- 3. Remove the SRAM card from the control panel.
- 4. Perform one of the following procedures:
  - If upgrading from versions 1.30–1.33, execute the SETUP/EXTENDED MENU/ADJ INT SIG-NAL menu.
  - If upgrading from versions 1.00–1.21, proceed as follows:
    - a. If signals other than RGB format are used, select the format for each signal and execute the CONTROL PRESET ADJ/AUTO menu.
      If the format is component video, execute the CONTROL PRESET ADJ/AUTO menu for each input slot.
    - b. Execute the SETUP/EXTENDED MENU/ ADJ INT SIGNAL menu.
      NOTE: To enter the EXTENDED MENU, type "1111" for the password.
    - c. Adjust color temperature in the COLOR TEMP ADJ menu.
