### DESCRIPTION

If BKM-11R is connected to BVM-D14H5 while the power of BVM-D14H5 is ON, the key layout of the monitor's control panel changes to the key layout of BKM-10R mode, causing a change in the orientation of the keys. To change the layout back, turn BVM-D14H5 OFF and ON.

When BKM-11R is inserted, the +5V power voltage of the HC board in BVM-D14H5 drops momentarily. The voltage drop is detected by an IC on the HC board, causing the HC board microprocessor to reset. As a result, the key layout of BVM-D14H5 changes to the key layout of BKM-10R mode.

To maintain the key layout for BVM-D14H5, connect BKM-11R to BVM-D14H5 while the power of BVM-D14H5 is OFF.
