DESCRIPTION

If the battery or AC adapter is subjected to excessive blows, the guide pin on the battery connector may bend, subsequently bending the battery connector contactor when the battery is reinstalled. As a result of insufficient contact, the power supply frequently shuts down for brief moments.

Replace the battery connector (1-766-377-12) with a new battery connector (1-766-377-13).

NOTE: The new battery connector is shaped differently and the contactor on the guide pin is rotated 90°. (See Figure 1.)


