- Auto color temperature adjustment has been improved.
- Previously, MAINTENANCE/BK BOARD(3/7)/R Y CLP OFFSET, B Y CLP OFFSET was not performed during the auto control preset adjustment. This has been corrected.
- ADDRESS short-cut operations have been modified. This feature now operates the same way as HDM/ BVM-G series.
